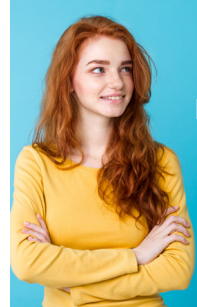

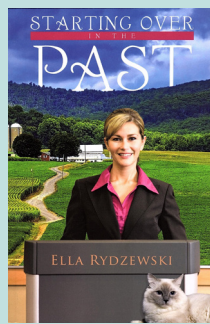
APPRECIATION FROM NIGERIA
